# Board Exam Results

The GeeKay World School students have proved once again that hard work has no substitute with their outstanding 100 percent results in Class 10 and 12 CBSE Board Examination 2023-2024. TGWS has been consistently performing at 100 percent results right from its first batch of Class 10 & 12. Samhitha Paari topped Class 10 with an aggregate of 477/500, Cheziyan stood second scoring 450/500. Sonakshi Jain has come in the third position with a score of 444/500. Samhitha Paari scored 98 in Mathematics, 95 in English Language and Literature, Tamil and Science and 94 in Social Science. Cheziyan has scored 94 in Tamil and Social Science and 93 in English Language and Literature. Sonakshi scored 93 in Social Science, 92 in Hindi and 90 in Science. Krisshiv Sarwin of Class 12 bagged first place scoring 447/500 and Praveen Kumar stood second with 437/500. Krisshiv secured 94 in Chemistry and Physics and 92 in English Core. 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# International Yoga Day

On the 21<sup>st</sup> of June, 2024, TGWS celebrated International Yoga Day to promote health and well-being. Yoga, as it's well known promotes physical, and mental health, spirituality, and longevity through its practices involving various body postures and meditation. The day started with a special assembly with students and teachers as participants. Our Grade 12 students hosted the assembly. The importance of Yoga was highlighted by our students which provided some valuable information about how yoga helps health and well-being. After the yoga prayer, there was a live demo cum presentation of yoga by the Isha Yoga Team, demonstrating a few vital asanas which could be practiced by children. Isha volunteers taught 'Neck and Shoulder practices', Nadi Suddhi, 'Ishya Kriya', 'Yoga Namaskar', and 'NadhaYoga' in a step-by-step way which our students joyfully learnt. The regular practice of some of these asanas can add flexibility, strengthen skeletal muscles, and rejuvenate the nervous system. Our Head of School, Mr. Ram Kumar addressed the students shedding more light on the significance of the occasion. The event concluded with our school song and National Anthem.



# Professional Development Session

The Professional Development session was meticulously planned from 27.06.24 to 01.06.24 to offer a comprehensive platform for teachers to augment their teaching practices. Understanding the pivotal role of continuous professional development in educational settings, the session was designed to encompass a myriad of activities aimed at honing teaching strategies and fostering collaborative learning.



Day 1 started with the session by The Head of School instilling a sense of pride and dedication in the teaching fraternity, laying a strong foundation for the subsequent activities through anecdotes, words of encouragement, and a vision for the future. Ms. Mujeeba conducted an insightful workshop on classroom management. She stressed the value of thorough organization and planning in managing a classroom, along with proactive strategies to anticipate and prevent misbehaviour. This session provided participants with practical insights and actionable strategies for improving classroom management.



A session on Goal Setting was conducted by Mr. Senthil. He engaged the participants in activities to identify personal and professional goals, create action plans, and discussed strategies for maintaining motivation and accountability.



A session on instructional technology was conducted by Ms. Logapriya focusing on leveraging digital tools to enhance teaching and learning. She demonstrated practical applications for integrating technology into facilitating personalized learning experiences with various technology tools including educational apps, online platforms, and multimedia resources. Participants gained hands-on experience to utilize instructional technology in their classrooms.



Ms. Nazira and Ms. Asha facilitated a session on leadership qualities, emphasizing the essential traits and skills needed for effective leadership. They discussed key attributes such as communication, empathy, integrity, and decision-making. Through interactive activities, participants explored different leadership styles and their applications in various scenarios.





Mr.Boopathy's session on Effective parent-teacher communication emphasized its critical role in supporting students' success. He underscored the importance of building trust, fostering open dialogue, and collaborating with parents to address student needs through regular updates, parent-teacher conferences, and digital platforms.

A workshop on assessment and evaluation was conducted by Ms. Sasikala, focusing on effective strategies for measuring student learning. She covered various assessment types, including formative and summative evaluations, and the importance of aligning assessments with learning objectives. The workshop offered practical tools and insights to enhance assessment practices and improve student outcomes.

Ms. Saranya's session on events in schools and the role of teachers emphasized the significance of extracurricular activities in enhancing students' overall development.

Mr. Naveen briefed the teachers about the programmes related to physical education throughout the year in TGWS. He also added some activities that will be introduced from this year like traditional games which usually seems to be missing in the schools today.
