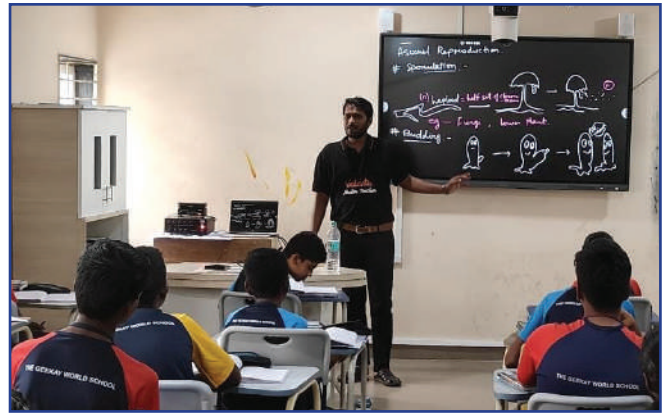
CM Trophy

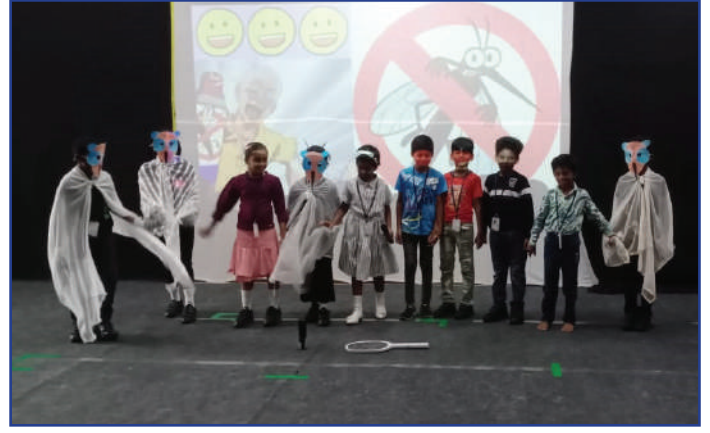
